References must be double-spaced and indented after the first line as shown.

Author's Last Name, First Name Middle Initial. *Title of Book: Subtitle of Book*. edition. Place of Publication: Publisher, Year. Name of Database. Place of access. Web. Date of access.

Example:

Roush, Chris. *Inside Home Depot: How One Company Revolutionized an Industry through the Relentless Pursuit of Growth*. New York: McGraw, 1999. *ebrary*. Web. 4 Dec. 2005.

APA eBook Citation

References must be double-spaced and indented after the first line as shown.

Author's Last Name, First Initial. Middle Initial. (Year of Publication). *Title of book: Subtitle of book*. edition. Retrieved from home URL for authoritative website

Author's Last Name, First Initial. Middle Initial. (Year of Publication). *Title of book: Subtitle of book*. edition. doi number
